Really Flexible Care was created to meet the local needs, rights, and interests of individuals with autism and to provide excellent residential services to those under the age of 18. RFC also support families to ensure that their family member receives excellent services; appropriate to their needs. The organisation is at the forefront of innovation in our field and has an excellent local reputation in the world of autism for supporting individuals with the most complex of needs.

Formed in 2008, we have grown rapidly, particularly over the last year. Today, RFC has a Head Office based in Milton Keynes and Regional Offices. We now have Revenue in excess of £.... million and over 70 staff in our current service provisions.

At our wadelow site we have an Independent Registered School and post 18 adult learning provision offering education at various levels and in a multitude of styles to individuals of all ages who are unable to access mainstream learning environments

We also have two smaller residential services offering respite and looked after services to individuals up to the age of 21.

RFC also offer outreach services and domiciliary care provision.

RFC is now venturing into new territory "Adult services". In July 2011 we open our two brand new state of the art provisions for adults with ASD, LD and PMLD.

Penniston Barn at Wadelow is an 8 bedded barn conversion offering care and education to individuals in transition between children and adult services.

Bruno's cottage in Kettering is a 5 bed service offering services to Adults with ASD and challenging behavioural issues and additional complex medical health needs.

RFC's Social worker and Family Liaison Officer are constantly working to raise awareness and help people with autism and their families in the local area and work in a multi-disciplinary fashion with many local authorities, charites and support groups.

RFC are aiming to become an accredited centre of excellence via the National Autistic Society.
